 Qualifications: The Midlands North Queen of Clubs is open to female golfers who are members of one of the following County Associations: Derbyshire, Leicestershire & Rutland, Lincolnshire, Nottinghamshire, Shropshire, and Staffordshire, who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current R&A Rules Limited and who hold a current Handicap Index. Entrants must be the Club Champion of an Affiliated Golf Club within the Midlands North Region, as above, at the closing date for entries which is 31st July 2022.

2. Regulations:

- a. Entry Forms accompanied by the appropriate Entry Fee, must reach the Organiser by the closing date.
- The Committee shall consist of a minimum of 3: the Organiser, the Chief Referee and one other host County Committee member.
- c. In all matters the decision of the Committee is final.

- e. The Committee reserves the right to arrange and /or alter starting times.
