CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

1, Qualifications

The Midlands North Queen of Clubs is open to female golfers who are members of one of the following County Associations: Derbyshire, Leicestershire & Rutland, Lincolnshire, Nottinghamshire, Shropshire, Staffordshire, who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current R&A Rules Limited and who hold an active CONGU Handicap. Entrant must be a current Club Champion of an Affiliated Golf Club within the Midlands North Region, as above as at closing date for entries which is Wednesday 8th August 2018. For most clubs, this is the Club Champion from 2017. In the absence of the current Club Champion being available a nominee of the Club's choice is allowed.

2. Regulations

- a) Entry Forms accompanied by the appropriate Entry Fee, must reach the Organiser by the closing date.
- b) The Committee shall consist of a minimum of 3: the Organiser, the Chief Referee and one other host County Committee member.
- In all matters the decision of the Committee is final
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without assigning a reason for its decision
- The Committee reserves the right to arrange and /or alter starting times
- In the event of adverse conditions the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result
- c) An active CONGU Handicap Certificate must be produced at Registration.
- d) Competitors should register at the Registration Desk no later than 20 minutes before their first tee-off time.
- e) If the competition is oversubscribed, there will be a waiting list.
- 3. Format & Conditions
- a) The Competition shall be played from the England Golf Tee Markers.
- b) The Queen of Clubs competition shall consist of 18 holes Stroke Play.
- c) In the event of a tie for the Douglas Bowl, there will be a "sudden death" Play Off, immediately after the last card has been returned, to determine the winner. All other ties shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole.
- d) A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14.3 for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
