

FOUR COUNTIES GIRLS CHAMPIONSHIPS - 2019

Your attention is drawn to the following rules

Girls must be under 18 on Jan 1st 2019

Girls must have attained a CONGU handicap of 36 or less at time of entry, except for 9 hole Stableford

Competitors are required to observe a reasonable standard of dress and etiquette on the course and in the clubhouse. Denim jeans, tracksuits and round neck tee shirts are not permitted on the course.

The use of trolley pullers or caddies is not permitted. Parents must stay off the fairways. They may assist in ball spotting but not give advice. (Except in 9 hole stableford where parents can walk around with their daughter).

Distance measuring devices are allowed.

Please help your child prepare for the event by making sure they have enough water etc.

If your child requires medication, they must have it available throughout the event and be able to self administer. Parents/guardians are totally responsible for ensuring their child receives any necessary medication. NCLGA cannot administer medication.

The club cannot accept any liability for injury caused to other persons by visiting players whilst on club property and all players acknowledge that they enter on to course or into club premises at their own risk and consent to the risk of loss, damage or injury caused.

Competitors are requested to report to the check in 30 minutes before their start time
